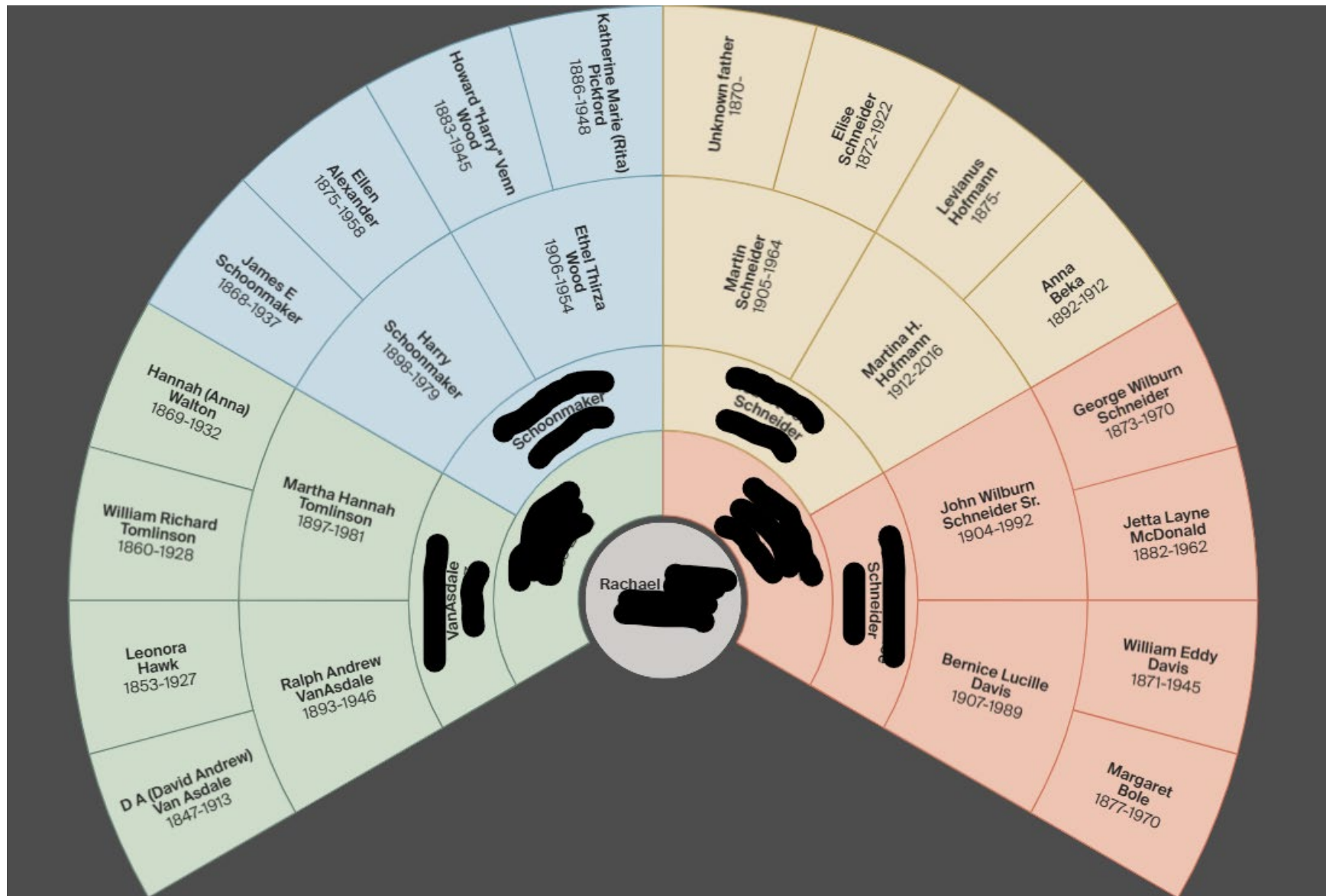

Genealogy of the Schneider family of Rüdenhausen, Germany → Rochester, NY → West Windfield, NY

The Schneider family how settled in West Windfield, New York immigrated to the United States from Rüdenhausen, Germany in 1927. The immigrant, Martin, joined his sister in Scranton, Pennsylvania and then moved to Rochester, New York. My grandparents settled in West Winfield, NY and raised their families. The majority of this family continues to reside in New York state.

Interestingly, the family surname is not “Schneider”. The Immigrant, Martin Schneider, his last name from his mother , his father has never been revealed on either birth documents or marriage documents. The origin and name of his father remains unknown and quite a mystery. I have ordered a Y DNA test and requested that a male cousin take the test to reveal the family name. It will be interesting to find out our family’s lineage after all these years.

If you ask why I cannot determine the family name through my existing Ancestry DNA submission (and my mother’s) it is because the closest relative who has taken a test is descended from Martin’s sister, Maria. All of the rest of the shared DNA matches are 4-8th cousins. I cannot determine from our matches which ones descend from Elise Schneider (Martin’s mother) or which ones descend from his father due to the small amounts of DNA that we share. Hopefully the Y DNA test will break this brick wall I am experiencing.

Life Summary

Martin Schneider was born in Rieden Vorksloster, Bregenz, Vorarlberg, Austria on March 5, 1905. At some point, he moved to live with his Uncle, Johann Wolfgang Schneider, at his black powder mill in Rüdénhausen, Germany, near the gates of Rüdénhausen castle. A first cousin of Martin's, Mathilde, described the black powder mill and the beautifully tended gardens in an article for her hometown when she turned 100. This is the uncle documented in Martin's immigration paperwork (as well as his sister Marie's paperwork).

It is a family rumor that Martin's family joined the NSDP (brown shirt party) and had to immigrate to the United States because they had run "afoul" of the party. When Martin immigrated, he used his mother's last name of Schneider and did not reference his father's name on any paperwork. I am unsure if this was done because he genuinely did not know his father's name (his birth record does not list a father) or if they were hiding the last name so they could immigrate. What I do know is that, when joining the Navy, my father was pulled into a supervisors office due to what was found on his background check in my mother's family. He was told that my mother had close relatives who worked in the Nazi camps as guards.

Martin arrived in Ellis Island on April 29, 1927, and was naturalized January 26, 1928. He first lived in Scranton, Pennsylvania, then with a "cousin", Herman Muller (his uncle's nephew by marriage) in Rochester, New York. He married Martina Hoffman¹, daughter of Levianus Hoffman and Anna Beka, on March 5, 1932. By 1940, he was working as a laborer in a Brewery and later changed to the landscaping industry.

Martin passed away April 24, 1964, in Rochester, Monroe, New York. His widow, Martina Hoffman, went on to marry Emil Roth.

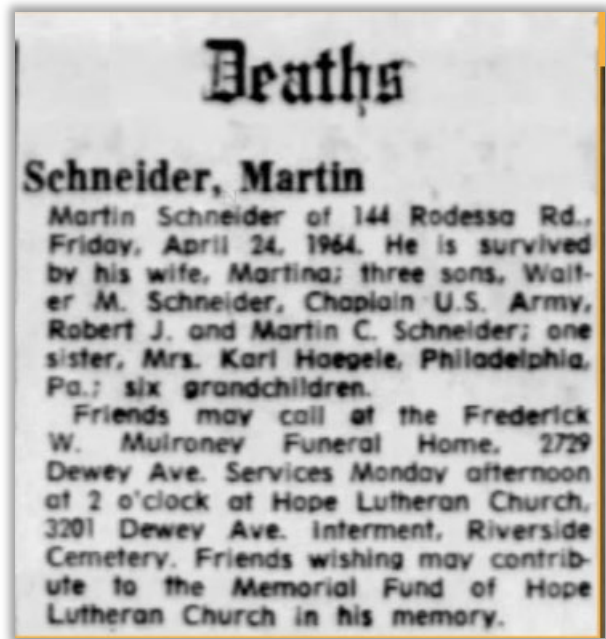
