RULES:

- 1. Parent/Legal guardian must complete a mandatory registration form and sign a release form for the child to participate.
- 2. Any regular ride in (not ride on) electric Power Wheel is allowed. Power Wheel must be provided by entry participants; Navajo County Fair does not supply them.
- 3. Children aged 4 to 10 years may participate. Drivers only. NO passengers allowed.
- 4. Helmets must be worn! A bicycle helmet is allowed.
- 5. Power Wheel must have seat belt or other driver safety restraint.
- 6. The vehicle is allowed to have UP TO a 12-volt lawn mower battery which cannot be mounted in the passenger seat. Battery must be secured and sealed away from the child.
- 7. Motors must remain stock, only batteries may be changed out (see rule 6).
- 8. All doors and tailgates must be strapped shut. No sharp edges. Use zip ties, duct tape, or other flexible material to ensure they stay shut. Hood must be secured AFTER inspection.
- 9. Stock tires only. Tires may be covered in duct tape to prevent them from cracking or breaking. No screws, chains, etc. on tires.
- 10. Each Power Wheel MUST have a number on the car. Decorative changes can be made (and are encouraged) to the Power Wheel to make it look like a derby car. There can be NO reinforcement to the Power Wheel. Changes may only be decorative.
- 11. Please remember this is for the kids, don't add something that could cause them to be eliminated from the derby. Any vehicle deemed unsafe or with unfair advantage will not be allowed to compete.
- 12. Everyone must pre-enter because every child will receive something.
- 13. One free Adult Pit Admission with each child entry.
- 14. All Power Wheels will be checked in at the pit gate.
- 15. One parent will be allowed in the back and on the track with their child during the event.
- 16. Three balloons will be attached by the Fair. The object is to pop the balloons. The last one left with a balloon is the winner.
- 17. If a child gets out of the Power Wheel during the event, that child is out of the event.
