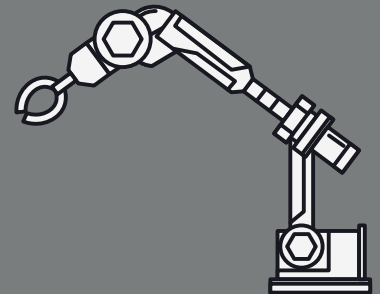
Skarda Equipment Company

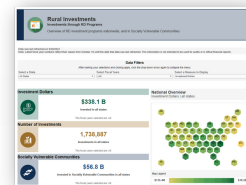
New USDA-RD Rural Data Gateway Resource



The USDA Rural Development program launched the Rural Data Gateway, a resource that makes it easier for partners and people living in rural communities to access the department's data for rural projects. This will not only help the USDA become a stronger partner, but also to better direct resources to the individuals who need them most in rural areas.

The rural investment dashboard in the Gateway features more than 20 data visualizations to spotlight investments made in the last 11 years through more than 65 programs. It is an easy-to-use tool that helps users analyze trends across topics such as:

- Geography by Congressional District

What is IIoT? - Blog

"Industrial Internet of Things" (IIoT) is a term that is gaining more and more traction throughout the manufacturing industry. IIoT refers to the networking of devices via the internet, and through the internet to database and software systems. Machinery of different types of brands can be connected via a variety of networking methods and connectivity protocols - even across vast distances - and data from these devices can be used holistically or as subsets, in real time or historically.

Manufacturers should not limit themselves to using data they currently understand how to collect, but instead, let loose creativity to develop wish lists. Ask staff to dream of what types of data they would love to have, and how that data might be used to improve processes and productivity. Chances are, IIoT service providers can help your company collect data in a way that is less cumbersome and expensive than imagined.



Technologies continue to evolve in the IIoT space, and the GPTMC is committed to continuing to learn and network with experts, so that it can assist regional manufacturers in finding the resources they need to become successful in the age of digitized manufacturing. Mark Your Calendars for the Four State Farm Show

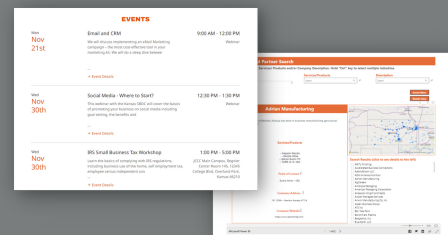
The GPTMC is teaming up with the K-State Technology Development Institute in a booth at the Four State Farm Show in Pittsburg, KS May 19-21st.
