- Miles of Smiles, the traveling dental program, will be here in October.
- Lindy Schenk had the new sign for the front of our building delivered today. It looks incredible!

The Principal/Superintendent report from Dr. Lindeman included:

• The vape detector and damage to the locker room have been reduced greatly. The Astoria Police Department came and completed a report for the vandalism.

• We are working with the energy group to re-evaluate the energy programs to change/lower the rates for the district. We are hoping to have the energy costs reduced by ending the current locked rate contract with Engie.

- We have investigated the Spoon River CEO program that Mr. Cameron brought to my attention. We believe it would be a good program to apply for, and I will move forward with that process.
- We have completed one fire drill with the Astoria Fire Department, one bus drill, and on the 22<sup>nd</sup> we have the law enforcement drill with the Astoria Police Department officer.
- With the newly built score table in the gym having a large flat display area, we would like to investigate selling advertising on the two sections directly behind the table.
- We applied for an energy program project with Ameren for energy kits. The kits have energy efficient items like bulbs, a shower head, foam seal kits, etc. All staff and high school and junior high students will receive a kit.
