



Prescription Reimbursement Program

What is the JTA Prescription Reimbursement Program?

The Jacksonville Transplant Alliance is offering a reimbursement on prescription medications to Mayo Clinic transplant recipients. All kidney, liver, heart, lung, and pancreas transplant recipients who have been transplanted at Mayo Clinic Jacksonville are eligible to receive this assistance. These reimbursements offer a one-time payment of up to \$100 to help patients pay for their prescription medications.

The details:

- Reimbursements are only available to solid organ post-transplant patients who have been transplanted at Mayo Clinic Jacksonville.
- Any prescription medication is eligible for reimbursement. Non-prescription medications are not covered.
- This is a one-time reimbursement for up to \$100 per patient.
- The \$100 reimbursement can be used for one or more medications.
- No personal financial information is required and there are no income limits to receive a prescription reimbursement.

What's required:

- A completed Prescription Reimbursement Form.
- Receipts or copies of receipts. Multiple receipts may be used to reach the \$100 maximum benefit.
- Pharmacy statements, such as those downloaded from pharmacy websites, may also be used.
- All receipts or statements must have your name, medication, and date on them.
- Receipts must be dated after January 1, 2023 and can include any receipts dated through the end of 2024.
- Only medications that are received through a retail pharmacy are eligible.
- Any pharmacy, including mail-order or specialty pharmacy within the U.S. may be used.
