## 2026 Changes

- Course completely revised, focused and streamlined
- New requirement to receive letter of recommendation from member of home SRC or a National Referee Coach
- New entry pathway option for current or recently retired FIFA/PRO/National match officials
- Defined in-person course length and requirement for in-course assessments requiring a passing grade

## 2026 Changes

## 2026 Changes

- Increased requirement for number of years as a Referee Coach, previously two (2) years
- Additional requirement to have been a National match official for three (3) years – not applicable to existing license holders
- Additional option of Provisional National Referee Coach for current or recently retired FIFA/PRO match officials

- Addition of requirement for camp attendance
- Removed practical assignments of Leading Video Analysis and Practical Training Exercise
