Our Purpose





Train Referees to become Better Referees

Some Questions:





You have a 8:00 am match, U-(any age)

• What time does the referee crew show up?

The Answer is...





- Thirty- Five (35) minutes prior, minimum.
- No exceptions.....period
- If you are going to be late call the assignor and crew
- If a Member of the Crew is late:
 - Text assignor at 30 min till kick-off
 - Call your assignor 20 min till kick-off

Game Time!!!





- Yet there are only two referees......
- WHAT DO I DO??????
 - The game must start on time.

The Only Solution





- The referee assigned is the referee
- The AR assigned is still the AR
- Find a person to act as a Club AR
- If the referee was the no show, the senior AR is now the referee

Referee arrives Late





• That referee then replaces the Club AR even if he was scheduled as the referee.

Two Referees Program?





- Not authorized by USSF in USSF affiliated games.....period
 - Zero Sanctioning
 - Zero Insurance
- No EXCEPTIONS!

Pre-Game





- Walk the field as a crew and check everything (Law 1)
 - Identify Early
- It is your responsibility as a crew
- Get the Pre Game instructions from the referee...none given? Ask for them!
- Check in the teams as a Crew.

What do we need to play?





- Well marked field
- Goals securely fastened to the ground
 - Sandbags, stakes
- Corner Flags
- If anything is wrong with the field it goes on the game report and inform your assignor.

After the Game is Over





- Paperwork/ Game Report/ Supplemental
 - Score, who won, who scored
 - Disciplinary Actions Cautions, Send-Offs
 - Anything else to help improve the game.
 - No corner flags, coach/spectator issues, a referee was late.
 - Supplemental Reports
- Learn and debrief with feedback senior ref

- Report on a Supplemental
 - First page on the website.
 - Any information you know about the member and email to your assignor and SRC Members on the home page of the Nevada Referee site.

- How to request an assessment:
- For either a video assessment request or an in-person assessment request.
 - Be assigned to a qualifying game (90 minutes in duration, U18 or older)
 - Send an email to <u>Dberry@daje2.com</u> to identify the date of the game and list the names and USSF numbers of the crew.
 - Email to be sent at least 2 weeks prior to the game allowing time to identify the assessor.

STANDARDS OF DRESS AND APPEARANCE **OFFICIAL U.S. SOCCER FEDERATION UNIFORM**

UNIFORM: Always make sure your uniform is clean, neat, and professional in appearance.

CLASSIC UNIFORM

SHIRT

- · Long or short sleeve
- · Yellow with black pinstripes
- · Men's or women's

BADGE

- . U.S. Soccer Federation with current year (securely fastened to shirt over left chest).
- . The badge should be for the highest grade for which the referee is currently qualified

SHORTS

- · Black shorts
- · Bottom edge of shorts not less than 3 or more than 7 inches above the top of the knee cap

SOCKS

- · Black socks
- · U.S. Soccer Federation Referee Program 2-stripe socks

SHOES

- · Black shoes
- · Black laces (may have white manufacturer's design)

Official Sports International is the official supplier of referee uniforms to U.S. Soccer.

Only manufacturer's logos and U.S. Soccer approved badges and/or emblems may be visible on the referee uniform.

ALTERNATIVE UNIFORMS

The following shirts have been approved by the Federation as alternatives that can be worn in case of color conflict. There is no order of preference among the alternate jerseys. The other parts of the referee uniform (shorts, socks, shoes) do not change if the referee wears an alternate shirt.




