The Bowery Jazz Messengers is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization founded in New York City by LaGuardia alumnus Bato Aydelotte '21. It provides opportunities for junior/high school jazz musicians to serve their community by performing for those experiencing homelessness and poverty at the Bowery Mission.

Bowery Jazz Messengers program is directed by musician/producer Chris Theberge (cofounder of Grammy-nominated Groove Collective). It offers young musicians a positive environment to develop their music skills and musicianship while receiving guidance from top professional NYC guest music mentors. Rehearsals take place on the second Saturday of each month from 1 pm to 4 p.m., and performances are held at the Bowery Mission Chapel on the third Saturday of the month at 12 p.m.
