A former corporate equity leader with over a decade of experience at companies like Google and Netflix, Victor transitioned from DEI strategy to behind-the-chair artistry to create the type of space he couldn't find: one where beauty meets wholeness, luxury meets safety, and hair is treated as both craft and care.

Victor's signature style blends precision cutting, expressive color placement, and texture mastery. His work spans editorial styling, private transformations, and education rooted in technical rigor and emotional intelligence. Whether sculpting soft fades, designing multidimensional color, or guiding new talent, he leads with presence and purpose.

He is actively building a body of work that champions intersectional beauty and equity—collaborating with creatives, clients, and educators who believe in transformation as both aesthetic and ethic.

Victor is currently developing:

- **Hues of Us** – a community-rooted, affirming event series celebrating the beauty, power, and nuance of LGBTQIA+ Black and Brown folx through free services, storytelling, and creative collaboration.
- **Prismatic Veiling** – his signature color technique that uses layered tones and strategic light placement to reflect a client's multidimensional identity, allowing different hues to emerge as the hair moves.
- **Affirmed & Aligned: Beauty Education That Liberates** – a coaching and education platform designed to train the next generation of liberated beauty professionals through affirming pedagogy, technical mastery, and a values-based approach to salon culture, texture inclusion, and identity-rooted service.

Through *Our S.P.A.C.E. Studios*—a sensory-safe, eco-conscious salon suite in the DC area—Victor continues to expand what beauty can mean, who it can serve, and how it can feel. His work is more than styling—it's restoration, reflection, and revolution.
