Our Approach

Strategies

Parent Consultation -

Meeting with a single parent or both parents to discuss educational and social development for their child (\$50/hr)

Grade Level Assessment -

Includes two academic apptitude tests to determine if a child is at their present grade level (\$375 for testing and parent conference / \$150 to add a report)

Educational Evaluation -

May be completed to include intelligence, academic aptitude, adaptive behaviors, and memory skills (\$875 for total evaluation)

College Major and Employment -

Includes two interest inventories, an evaluation of true job placement options, and insight to realistic wages for a chosen major (\$250 for testing + 1 hour interview)

College Major and Return on Investment -

Compares college, probability of employment and post-graduation wages, offering students and parents a true understanding of their investment

(\$1500 - 1 hr interview with student, report, 2 hr interview parents and student)

Parent Support Groups -

Offers support for parents with varying disabilities. Groups consists of 5-8 single or sets of parents. Meeting time is 1 hour 20 minutes. (\$10 per meeting. If a set of parents come, \$5 per parent)
