New Delhi is the capital of India. New Delhi and Delhi combined are called the National Capital Territory of Delhi. Along with this, the national capital region is much broader, in which various neighboring districts and places are also included. These are Gurgaon, Faridabad, Noida, Ghaziabad.

Firstly the foundation of New Delhi was introduced by George V in 1911 during the Delhi durbar. Herbert Baker and Edwin Lutyens fabricated the whole map of New Delhi. The inauguration of Delhi was done on 13 February 1931. The Viceroy and Governor-General Irwin inaugurated New Delhi for the first time.
