Summer is past and we hope you all had a great season, and enjoyed the wonderful weather that we were blessed with. The school term started 1st week of October 2018. The first week still saw heavy monsoon rains, and we saw children and their parents braving the weather to walk the distance to get to school. Our new young children are settling into school routine well, and children that moved from Rainbow Class to Butterfly class, have adjusted well to their new classroom and teacher.

At present in The Gambia humidity is 80% and temperatures are reaching 33 degrees, (which feels like 38 degree) there is so much water lying around the community after the monsoon season, which causes cholera and malaria.

CHANGES IN DIRECTION.

Over this summer, we as a Charity, have had time to reflect on the journey we are on. We want to reach out further, and work harder, to ensure we get the new school build built, so that we can educate a further 40 children in a time frame of April 2020.

There is 10 weeks to Christmas, and many of us will be thinking of what presents and gifts to buy our loved ones.

Please spare a thought to those who live in poverty, that do not have enough money for their next meal for themselves or their family, that do not have a bed to sleep on, or a dry room to rest in. Our aid has arrived safely, and is waiting for the next team leaving on 20th November 2018, to distribute out.

We pray that we can give out some clean bedding, hand out some well needed clothing, and supply a wheel chair or two to any person that requires some freedom to get out from behind closed doors.

This Christmas trip, we have shipped over Christmas presents, which were kindly wrapped and donated by some very kind hearted people, plus Father Christmas will be in at-

Nursery school education in The Gambia is private sector. The costs to parents and guardians is very expensive. Education is the future, and an early start in life is key. Here at Ebo Town Community Nursery School, we offer ALL our children a FREE education, thanks to the sponsorship programme.

From as little as £25.00 A YEAR, you can sponsor a child. You will be allocat-

ed a little boy or girl, whom you can support as much or as little as you like. This fee goes towards the child's two uniforms, all teachers salaries, and all school equipment. Some sponsors like to send additional money for the child's family to buy Rice or mosquito nets. Some sponsors like to send a small gift out at Christmas.

TEACHING STAFF

We start our new school terms 2018/2019, with 4 wonderful teachers.

MARTINA— Is on a probation period at present, is 34 years old, and working as our New Head of School. She is teaching in our Butterfly Class, 5—7 year olds. Martina is in her final year of Teacher training college, and is

self funding.

CHRISTINE—works alongside Martina, as a teachers assistant. We as a charity are supporting Christine through Teacher Training College, and she is in her first year.

LENNA—is awaiting certification, as she has completed her 3 years of Teacher training

college, and will be a qualified teacher. Lenna teaches in our Rainbow Class, 3—5 years. The charity have supported Lenna through college.

FATOUMATTA - works with Lenna in Rainbow Class, as a teaching assistant. Fatoumatta hopes to start Teacher training college soon.

AID AND COMMUNITY WORK

After lots of deliberation, by the Trustees, a hard decision has been made, to postpone sending aid out to the Community.

Each box costs us £30.00 to send on a container, we do not have anywhere to store aid, and box it up in Shrewsbury, plus we have to pay, transportation from the docks to the school once it arrives in The Gambia. We feel as a Trust that the build is a priority at this present moment, and all

money we are raising, MUST go towards getting the new school built, to help extra children and their families.

We will still give sponsors an opportunity to help their sponsored families, with Rice aid etc, two times a year, on team trips out, but we will not be putting out any further general appeals for the time being.

Other ways to help at the moment, is to buy a brick for 15p per brick.

THE BIG BUILD PROJECT.


Land was purchased in April 2018, when a team visited the school. We have got the land secured, with a large wall, with security wire, and large double metal gates. A septic tank is in position and was completed before the monsoon season arrived. Building plans have

been passed in June 2018, for a 3 classroom school to be built, with an office and aid room. Rick McIntosh—a Trustee, will be visiting the land in November 2018, and his challenge will be to build relations with a construction team, and get the foundations costed out.

Rick's aim is to work with local labourer's giving an opportunity

of employment within this poor community.

Rick will be liaising with the planning department, and working closely with them. We have been given an estimated quotation of £10,000 for foundations to be installed. We are stepping up our fundraising to be able to get the foundations completed ASAP.
