Deputies conducted welfare checks to ensure the safety of vulnerable residents, performed park checks to maintain secure recreational spaces, and completed contract checks to reinforce security in designated areas. Public infrastructure and MUD building checks were conducted to protect facilities from vandalism and unauthorized access. Neighborhood patrols and community engagement were carried out, while vacation checks provided additional security for unoccupied residences.

Traffic safety was emphasized through proactive traffic stops and enforcement efforts aimed at reducing hazardous driving behaviors and promoting roadway safety. Collectively, these measures enhanced community safety, deterred criminal activity, and reinforced public confidence in law enforcement.
