Printing

- Download files to your computer and then print
- Print in portrait mode, 8.5x11 paper using high quality settings
- Colors may vary by printer and paper
- Try vellum, patterned paper, or laser printing for wet mediums

Cutting & Assembly

- Small sharp scissors work best and for detailed cuts, move the paper more than the scissors
- Leaving a slight white border can feel more forgiving
- Use double-sided tape, glue sticks, Mod Podge or stitching.

Ideas & Inspiration

- Use these for bookmarks, journals, gift tags, mixed media projects, and home decor
- Search Instagram for junk journal ideas or paper collage crafts

There's no right way to collage.

Rearrange, layer, experiment, and have fun!
