As a significant milestone in Gannon University's Centennial Year, the Alumni House will be unveiled in September 2025 and will serve as the "front door" to the University for alumni and friends. Its location within the footprint of Gannon University's Erie campus is highly visible and near Old Main, Nash Library, the Admission's Office, Schuster Theater, McConnell Family Stadium and the Recreation and Wellness Center. The Alumni House is also convenient to many downtown establishments.

The Alumni House on Erie's "Millionaires Row" is being restored while preserving its historic integrity. Formerly known as the Frederick Jarecki House, the architecturally stunning house boasts a combination of Eclectic (stone) and Tudor (timber) styles, offering a distinguished yet comfortable space for flexible use. Indoor and outdoor space is available for alumni reunions, homecoming, gatherings, receptions, ceremonies, and meetings. In addition, the Alumni House will provide office space for the University Advancement staff.
