St. Paul Peterson, dubbed St. Paul by Prince in 1985 when he asked him to be the lead singer for his group The Family. He originally joined the Prince camp in "Morris Day and The Time" in 1983 and appeared on their double platinum album "Ice Cream Castles" and in the movie "Purple Rain." He was a part of their biggest hits "Jungle Love" and "The Bird." When Morris Day went solo, Prince chose Paul to be the lead singer of his newest group The Family, who were the first to release the song "Nothing Compares 2 u."
