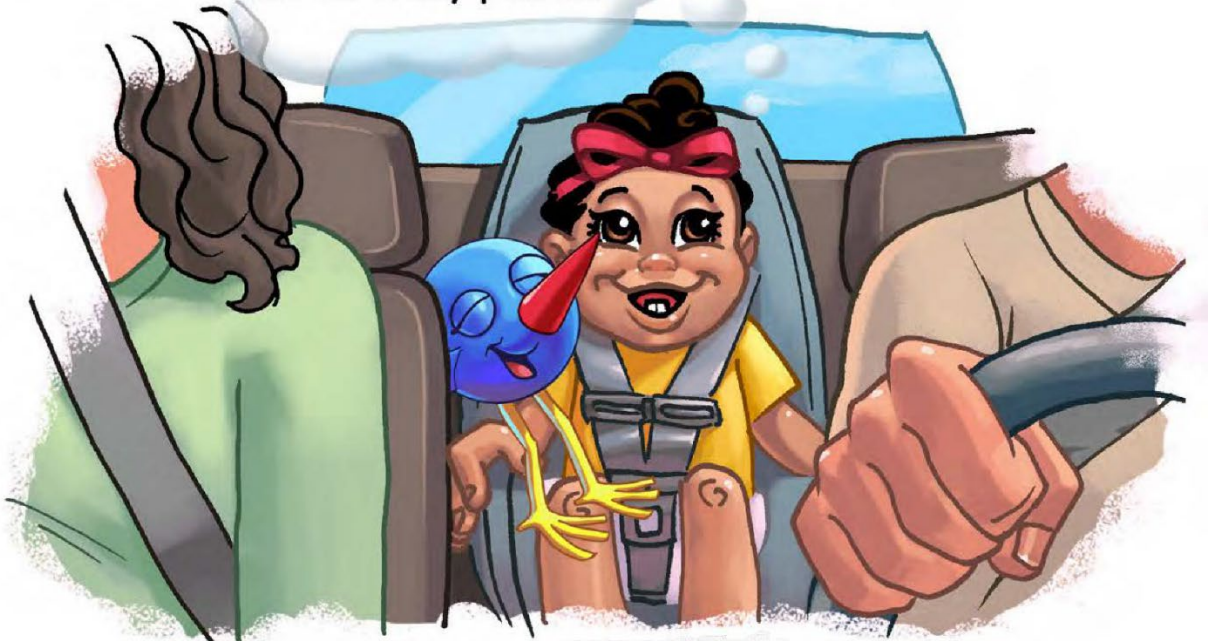

and organic soil to dig in.

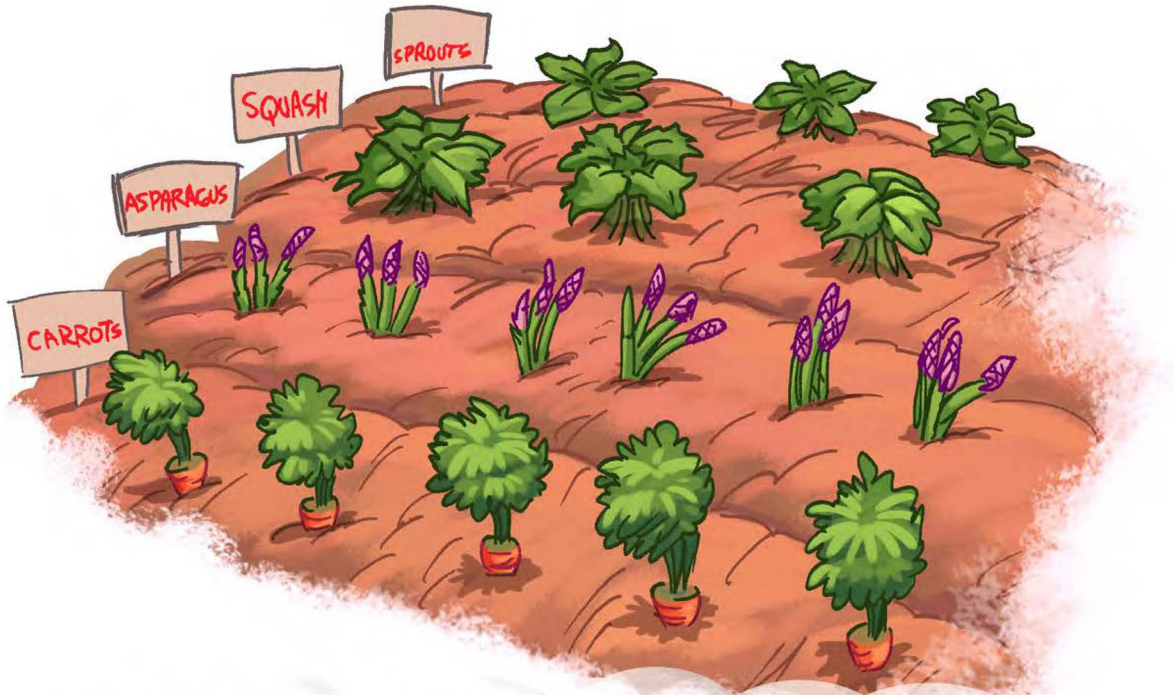




I hold Chip tight with my reading blocks in sight.

and Brussels sprouts too...**

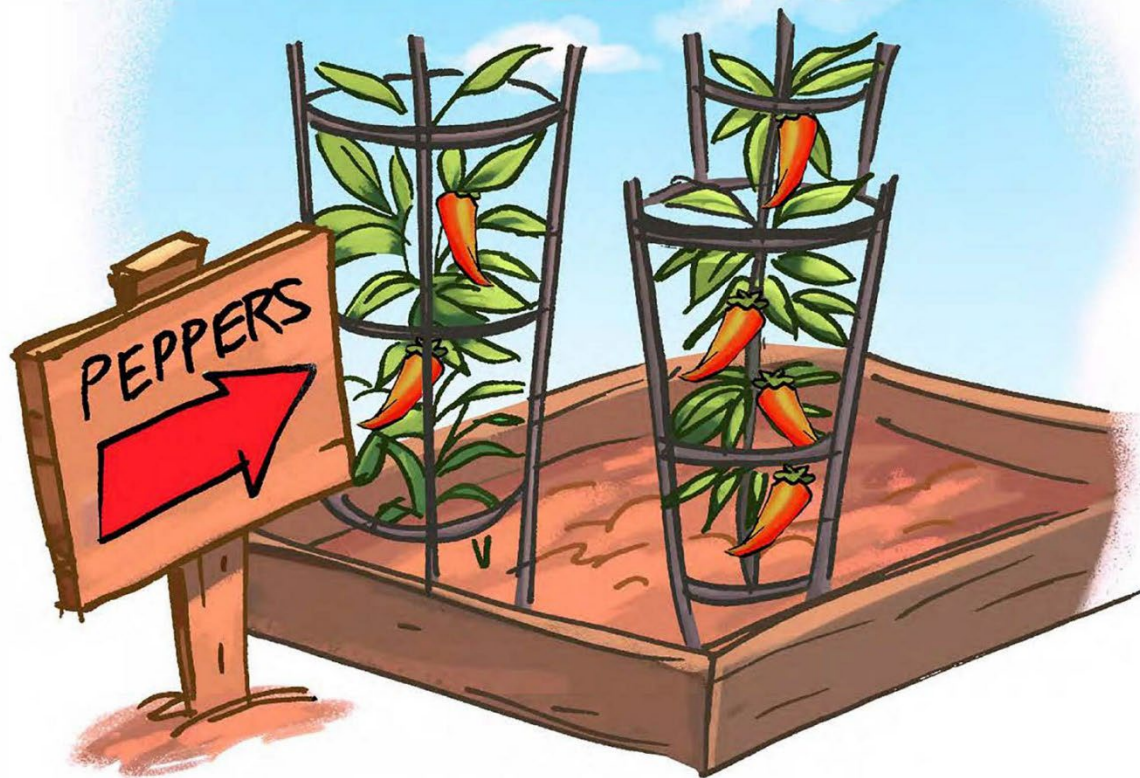
with cabbage, collard greens,

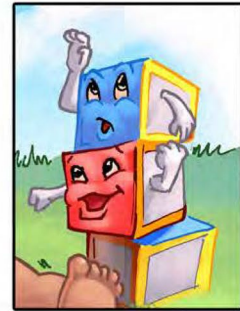
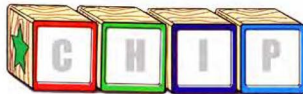
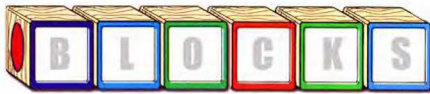
