April 14, 2026
Monthly Meeting Minutes

The monthly meeting of the Atlanta Township Board was held April 14, 2026, at the Atlanta Township Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Supervisor Julie Osborn. Those present were Supervisor Julie Osborn; Clerk Shellie Reed; Trustees Georgia Green, Joshua Koonce, Chuck Van Hoorn and Bruce Compton; Highway Commissioner Wes Green and Cemetery Manager Shelly Brooks. The guests present were Harold Green and Martha Green.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Osborn.

The following items were discussed:

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There was no public comment.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the March 9, 2026 meeting were reviewed by each member. Trustee Green made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee Van Hoorn seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and the motion passed to approve the minutes of the March 9, 2026 meeting as presented.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Supervisor Osborn had nothing to report.

CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk Reed reminded everyone to do their Economic Interest forms and if possible, print a copy when it is completed for our files.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER REPORT: Highway Commissioner Green reported the following: roads were grated after the rains and need to be done again; corn stalks were plowed off a few roads due to the rains and water runoff; a hole developed on 2400th Street at the culvert which was about 4 feet deep requiring 8 ton of 3/8 rock to fill it – the culvert is rusted and he is working with Brett at Logan County to get a quote for replacing it.

CEMETERY REPORT: Cemetery Manager Brooks reported the following: on March 20 a cremation burial was held for Tom and Linda Reinhart; on March 21 a traditional burial was held for Charles Koller; on April 3 a traditional burial was held for James Wayne Tibbs; a family needed assistance finding a plot which she was able to locate for them; Manley's Memorials fixed stones which were damaged last year in the vandalism and had somehow moved again while they were at the cemetery putting up a new stone; there is a pending burial of Dorothy Ortiz at the foot of her mother but no date yet; and inquiry was made from a family on how much they originally paid for spaces and she researched that for them.

OLD BUSINESS: 2026-2027 Budget – no public comment has been received on the budget. Trustee Green moved to accept the proposed budget as final. Trustee Koonce seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: Ayes – 5; Nays – 0. The motion carried and the proposed budget was approved as the final budget and will be submitted to Logan County.

NEW BUSINESS: There was no new business.

FINANCIAL REPORT & PAYING OF BILLS: Board Members reviewed the bills to be paid. Trustee Van Hoorn made a motion to approve the financial report and paying of the bills. Trustee Compton seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: Ayes: 5; Nays: 0. The motion carried and bills were authorized for payment.

Supervisor Osborn adjourned the meeting at 7:54 PM.
