Monthly Meeting Minutes

The monthly meeting of the Atlanta Township Board was held January 9th, 2024, at the Atlanta Township Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:32 P.M. by Clerk Shellie Reed. Those present were Clerk Shellie Reed; Trustees Amy Wertheim, Georgia Green, and Chuck Van Hoon; Cemetery Manager Shelly Brooks and Highway Commissioner Wes Green. Supervisor Julie Osborn and Trustee Becky Brandt were absent. There was no public present.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Clerk Shellie Reed.

Clerk Reed asked for a nomination for a Pro Tem Chairman in the absence of Supervisor Osborn. Trustee Green nominated Trustee Van Hoon. Trustee Wertheim seconded the motion. A roll call vote was held: Ayes:3; Nays: 0. The motion carried and the nomination of Trustee Van Hoon to be the Pro Tem Chairman was approved.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the December 12, 2023, meeting were reviewed by each member. Trustee Green made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk Reed distributed the quarterly budget report for review.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER REPORT: Highway Commissioner Green reported the following: trucks are ready for the snow we are supposed to get this week and weekend.

CEMETERY REPORT: Cemetery Manager Brooks reported the following: a traditional burial was held on January 6 for Richard McKown; the 2023 report for the Illinois Oversight Database has been completed; meeting dates for the Advisory Board have been posted.
