June 9, 2026
Monthly Meeting Minutes

The monthly meeting of the Atlanta Township Board was held June 9, 2026, at the Atlanta Township Building. The meeting was called to order at 7:30 P.M. by Supervisor Julie Osborn. Those present were Supervisor Julie Osborn; Clerk Shellie Reed; Trustees Georgia Green, Joshua Koonce, Bruce Compton and Chuck Van Hoorn; Highway Commissioner Wes Green and Cemetery Manager Shelly Brooks. The guests present were Harold Green and Martha Green.

The Pledge of Allegiance was led by Supervisor Osborn.

The following items were discussed:

PUBLIC COMMENTS: There was no public comment.

MINUTES OF PREVIOUS MEETING: The minutes of the May 12, 2026 meeting were reviewed by each member. Trustee Green made a motion to approve the minutes as presented. Trustee Van Hoorn seconded the motion. A vote was taken, and the motion passed to approve the minutes of the May 12, 2026 meeting as presented.

SUPERVISOR'S REPORT: Supervisor Osborn had nothing to report.

CLERK'S REPORT: Clerk Reed reported all Economic Interest Statements have been received and she will be submitting to the county.

HIGHWAY COMMISSIONER REPORT: Highway Commissioner Green reported the following: he has called GFL to inquire about large dumpster rentals for a clean – up day but has not heard back; Getz came in and checked the fire extinguishers; he met with Scott to discuss cold patching but has not finalized details.

CEMETERY REPORT: Cemetery Manager Brooks reported the following: on May 23 a traditional burial of Richard Fugate was held; there is a problem with the footing of an Adam's Memorials stone for the Garner family which is very large and extends into next space and Al is not sure how to handle it; Bob Hildebrand called wanting to sell 2 spaces but she has not spoken to him yet.

OLD BUSINESS: Cemetery Sexton Bid Review - two bids were received – one from Kory Leesman and one from Al Adams; one bid is for \$24,000 and one is for \$26,000; Trustee Compton made a motion to accept Al Adams bid; Trustee Van Hoorn seconded the motion; A roll call vote was taken: Ayes: 5; Nays: 0. The motion carried and Al Adams bid for Cemetery Sexton from July 1, 2026 – June 30, 2027 was accepted.

NEW BUSINESS: There was no new business.

FINANCIAL REPORT & PAYING OF BILLS: Board Members reviewed the bills to be paid. Trustee Compton made a motion to approve the financial report and paying of the bills. Trustee Green seconded the motion. A roll call vote was taken: Ayes: 5; Nays: 0. The motion carried and bills were authorized for payment.

Supervisor Osborn adjourned the meeting at 8:45 PM.
