

The Campbell County Agriculture Complex is a new addition to the Campbell County Extension Service, which is a branch of the University of Kentucky Cooperative Extension Service. The mission of Extension is to bring unbiased, research-based information from the University of Kentucky to the county level to educate and improve the Campbell County community. The Agriculture Complex was prioritized as a need due to the large animal veterinarian shortage, lack of accessibility to basic services, and other challenges that Campbell County farmers are facing. The goal of the facility is to respond to that need by bridging the gap in the infrastructure that is limiting farmers' potential and productivity, and help keep agriculture alive and profitable in Campbell County. The Agriculture Complex offers a safe livestock handling facility for all species with scales and hoof trimming chutes, and will offer marketing opportunities for producers to sell out of the facility in addition to the other services that Cooperative Extension has traditionally offered, including soil, hay, and diagnostic testing.

RULES OF THE ROAD:

Eleven diverse farms have opened their gates for you to experience local agriculture first-hand. Take this opportunity to meet local farmers, taste farm-fresh food, learn stewardship and farm skills from experts, and explore the fields of local farms.

- · No admission is charged for the Farm Tour.
- Dress for a farm visit, wear sturdy shoes that can get dirty and bring all-weather clothing.
- · Be aware and considerate of farm animals. Follow the farmers' instructions and wash your hands after handling animals.
- DO NOT bring pets with you on the tour.
 Farm animals may be frightened by strange animals, even well trained pets, and this can lead to dangerous situations. These are working farms with animals – please be respectful.
- Many of the farms will have food and beverages for sale and most will have handicapped restrooms available.
- · BRING A COOLER so you can purchase farm fresh produce, freezer beef and more items that will be available at some of the farms.
- · Ask a volunteer for a farm tour survey to help us count attendance and share your feedback. Future farm tours depend on this information.
- · Have fun and bring a sense of adventure. Don't forget your camera.
