## WHAT IS A COST OF COMMUNITY SERVICES STUDY?

The study measures the fiscal relationship, or ratio, between revenues and expenditures. revenues and expenditures are allocated into residential. commercial/industrial, and farm/ agricultural land uses. The ratio is then calculated for all three types of land uses.

### WHY DO A COST OF COMMUNITY SERVICES STUDY?

Stakeholders seek to understand the ratio of expenditures to revenues when faced with land use decisions. A cost of community services study outlines where the government spends more on services provided, as compared with the revenues generated.
