Reimbursement 50% of project cost up to \$1,500

- Cover Crops
- Dead Animal Composting

- Limiting Surface Water Access
- Manure Storage Structures
- Pasture and Hay Land
- Planned Grazing Systems
- Septic System Repair
- Stormwater Management Systems
- Water Harvesting

Dead Animal Removal

\$100 paid by the District; the remainder paid to the contractor by the landowner at the time of pickup.

Two pickups her household per fiscal year July 1- June 30.


Approvals are at the discretion of the Conservation Distict, funds available until funding is exhausted.

2026 Program Timeline

- Application Accepted Beginning: December 8 (in order received)
- Notice to approved applicants
 January 19 (until all funds exhausted)
- Deadline to complete practice and submit for reimbursement
 May 1
