REQUIRED PERMIT FEE SHALL BE DOUBLED FOR HAZARDOUS LOCATION AREA WIRING AS DEFINED IN ARTICLE 500 OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICAL CODE (GASOLINE PUMPS, SPRAY BOOTHS, ETC...)

This permit becomes void if work or construction authorized is not commenced within 180 days or if construction or work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 days at any time after work is commenced or at the end of 24 months, whichever occurs first. Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with the Cedar Creek Township Inspection Department. All installations shall be in conformance with the Township Electrical Code. NO WORK SHALL BE CONCEALED UNTIL IT HAS BEEN INSPECTED.

PLAN REVIEW REQUIREMENTS

Plans and specifications for new construction work, alterations, repair, expansion, addition, or modification work shall be prepared by, or under the direction supervision of, an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to Act. NO. 299 of the Public Acts of 1980, as amended, and shall bear that Architect's or Engineer's signature and seal. A plan review is required before a permit can be issued. EXCEPTION: Single family dwelling less than 3500 square feet or minor repairs or alterations.

HOMEOWNER AFFIDAVIT

I hereby certify the Electrical work described on this permit application shall be installed BY MYSELF IN MY OWN HOME in which I am living or about to occupy. All work shall be installed in accordance with the Township Electrical Code and SHALL NOT BE ENCLOSED, COVERED UP or put into operation until it has been INSPECTED AND APPROVED by the Township Electrical Inspector. I will cooperate with the Township Electrical Inspector and assume the responsibility to arrange for necessary inspections. SIGNATURE OF HOMEOWNER _____
