## 1. Get ready for your trip



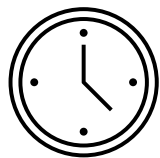

## 2. Important information

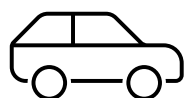


- ★ Check in: 4PM

- ★ Tap water is safe for drinking.

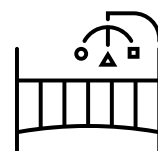


- ★ Please park near the cabin and leave the large turnaround area clear.

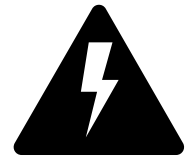


- ★ **Quiet hours** are between 10PM and 9AM. During this time, please respect the neighbours by turning off any outdoor music and lowering your voice.

### 3. No power or water?

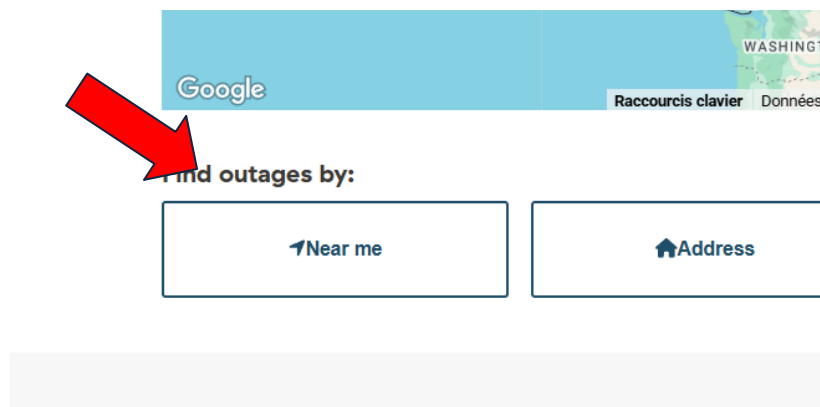


If you get to the property and there is no power and no water, it looks like there is a general power outage.

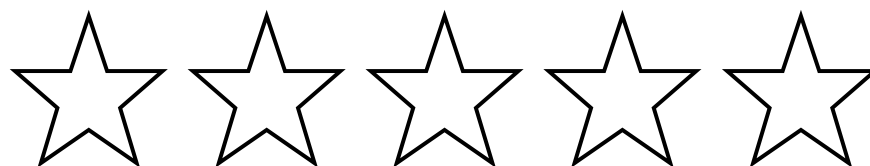


## 5. Check-out procedure

- ✓ Check out time is at 11:00 AM sharp.
- ✓ Dirty dishes must be cleaned and dishwasher started.
- ✓ Don't strip the sheets off the bed, leave as is.
- ✓ Bring all towels next to the laundry machine and start a load with the colored items only.
- ✓ All garbage and recycling must be brought to the designated area in Section 2.

Linens for the sofa bed are located inside the lounge section.

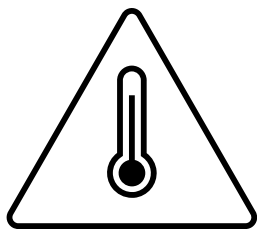
## 7. Pets

## 8. Room Temperature

To adjust the room temperature, use the white remote controls. The wall mounted thermostat is for the heated floor and is locked.



## 9. Fire Pit

Firewood for the fire pit is provided. There is a pile located at the entrance of the property, near the grey/black building.

We will keep you informed regarding the fire ban in place in BC through Airbnb.

Additionally, there will be a notice placed in the fire pit.

## 10. BBQ Grill

You will find a guide on how to use the BBQ on your cabin's table. Propane is provided. There is an extra tank next to the BBQ, please use the guide to see how to connect it.

Please wash the BBQ tools after use and burn off any excess food to ensure no animals are attracted.



## 11. Speakers/TV

Airplay is available to play your favorite hits; just make sure to choose the speaker that match your cabin number: Pur Lodging #1, #2 or #3.

Cable TV is provided. To access it, press the Guide/List button on the remote.

To access a platforms directly, click on the respective platform button. **You will need to enter your own login information.**

## 12. Coffee Machine

Your coffee machine is equipped with a reusable coffee capsule. Simply fill the capsule with your desired amount of ground coffee, close it and insert into the machine like a regular pod. Enjoy!



## 13. Hot Tub

- The hot tubs are treated between every guest. We use chlorine as main sanitizer. Please leave the floating puck distributor in the hot tub.
- The temperature is locked at 100° in the summer and at 104° in the winter.
- Take a shower before getting in. Soap or cream will create foam and will damage the equipment. Also, remove grass or rocks under your feet.
- Do not bring glass into the hot tub; plastic cups are provided.
- To increase/decrease jet strength, manually turn the jet itself.
- To turn on the hot tub and start jets : press the JET button twice. To stop the jets : press the JET button once.
- You don't need to close the hot tub when finished, it will automatically turn back to its regular cycles. Simply put the cover back on.
- The water level shown on below pictures is the highest that this hot tub can be. The top jets will never be underwater.



## Warnings

Children are at higher risk of overheating than adults. Keep children under the age of 7 out of the hot tubs. Their small bodies do not regulate temperature well and overheat too quickly.

Children over the age of 7 and pregnant women should use hot tubs at lower temperatures and for shorter durations.

Alcoholic beverages and some drugs can cause drowsiness. They can also lower the body's resistance to the effects of overheating. Do not consume these when using the hot tub.
