Church Family,

It is hard to believe that we are already heading into June! It is always an exciting time of year, not just for the children, because summer time seems to always break up our regular routines for a while. The kids are off and suddenly we are spending more time together, we are planning vacations, and enjoying the gift of God's nature more than before. Breaking up the normalcy of life can be a very good thing, and especially for our relationship with the Lord.

God calls us to walk with Him daily, and it's impossible to think about answering that call without the normal routine of our lives being shaken up. If you think about those who followed God in scripture, He always took them somewhere they wouldn't have been otherwise. For some people their lives were flipped totally upside down, and God used them to do incredible things that there is no way they could have accomplished on their own.

Consider Jesus' disciples. It is fair to say that when Jesus first called them, the disciples' lives changed forever. They were no longer able to continue about the things that normally occupied their time. They put down their nets, left behind their boats, and followed Him. If this wasn't enough, in Luke, Chapter 9:1-5, Jesus does something unexpected, and what I would guess had to be pretty terrifying for the disciples. He sends them out to do ministry on their own!

1) Then He called His twelve disciples together and gave them power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. 2) He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick. 3) And He said to them, "Take nothing for the journey, neither staffs nor bag nor bread nor money; and do not have two tunics apiece. 4) "Whatever house you enter, stay there, and from there depart." 5) "And whoever will not receive you, when you go out of that city, shake off the very dust from your feet as a testimony against them." 6) So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.

We can only imagine what it was like to be the disciples, hearing these marching orders from the Lord. It surprises me that we don't see any protest from them! "But Jesus, how can we do this if you're not with us?"

The truth is, that Jesus was going with them. When He sent them with His authority, He was giving them everything they needed. Whatever the situation they found themselves in, no matter how difficult it seemed, whether they were rejected or accepted, they had what they needed in Him. And in Mark 6:30-31, is the account of the disciples returning, sharing stories of their ministry with Jesus, and Jesus taking them to share in a quiet time of rest.

There is incredible joy in answering the call of God in our lives. I pray today that God will give you a clear understanding of just where He wants to lead you. It may not be easy, but God always enables us to fulfill what He is calling us to do. Even if we face trouble and persecution, there is always blessing in walking obediently after our Lord. Today, be willing to let Him break up your routine and lead you somewhere new in faith.
