# March Newsletter 2026

Dear Family,

Easter this year is Sunday, April 5th. While we celebrate the resurrection every Sunday, Easter is certainly the day that increased emphasis is given to the greatest event of history, the resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ from the dead. I want to encourage you to use the month of March to be intentional about preparing your heart for this special season. I want to ask you to focus on a personal question, "What does the cross of Christ mean to me?" Don't think about it once and be done. Try to make it an ongoing meditation throughout the month and invite the Holy Spirit to increase your revelation and give you a deeper love for the complete work of His cross.

*Below I've written out a few truths we can hold to because of the cross.*

Because of **THE Cross** - Throughout history more people were crucified than can be counted. However, here I refer to one cross; the Cross of Christ. It is like no other cross because of the One who died upon it, and because of what happened following His death.

When I, and for the most part the Scriptures, refer to the Cross of Christ, I/we are referring to His death, His burial, and His resurrection. Listed below are a few things that I/we can know are true because of the cross. I'm going to write these statements in the first person and I hope you can read them in the first person trusting what God has said.

- I know I am loved; not because I'm loveable or good, but **because God proved His love for me, having Christ die for me even when I was a sinner. Romans 5:8**
- I know that I am reconciled (at peace) with God, **because Jesus came for the purpose of reconciling me to God, and God hasn't counted my sins against me because He laid them upon His perfect Son. 2 Corinthians 5:19-21**
- I know I am righteous before God **because, not only did Jesus take my sin upon Himself, He gave me His righteousness as a gift. 2 Corinthians 5:21**
- I know I have victory over sin, death, the grave, and every evil thing **because His word teaches me to say "Thanks be to God who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ." 1 Corinthians 15:58**
- I know that as I seek to serve the Lord, even in my weakness He still uses me, and when I seem to have success, I have nothing to boast about **because all my boasting should be completely in the Cross of Christ. Galatians 6:14**

*I often refer to us as family. Because we have been cleansed from sin, and purchased with the blood of the Lamb, we have been adopted into the family of God and become an eternal family born again of His Spirit. Let's seek to live in a way that demonstrates our love one for another and, therefore, brings joy to the heart of our family.*

*So grateful for the work of the cross. I love you,*
