*If we don't know someone well, we may find it difficult to know how we should pray for them. Listed below are several things taken directly from Scripture. By using this, we can have confidence in praying. I am not suggesting that you pray the entire list. I would suggest that you read through the list from time to time to become more aware of various things for which to pray.*

2 Peter 3:18 - For them to grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Matthew 6:33 - For them to seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness.

Matthew 4:19 - That they will follow Christ and seek to win souls

Matthew 6:20 - That they will lay up treasures in heaven.

Matthew 7:24 - That they will build their lives on the solid foundation of God's word.

Matthew 5:6 - That they will hunger and thirst for righteousness

Matthew 9:36 - That they will have compassion for those who don't know the Lord.

Luke 4:18 - That they will be anointed to preach (proclaim) the gospel to the poor and to heal the broken hearted.

John 3:3 - That they will positively be born again.

Matthew 3:2, 4:17 - That they will walk in the way of true repentance.

John 3:30 - That they will have the heart of John the Baptist - that Jesus must increase and they must decrease.

Acts 4:13 - For there to be clear evidence in their lives that they have been with Jesus.

Acts 10:38 - That they would be anointed with the Holy Spirit and power and go about doing good and delivering those who are oppressed of the devil.

Romans 1:16 - That they will not be ashamed of the gospel

Romans 8:11 - That they would count themselves to be dead to sin, but alive to God.

John 4:24 - That they choose to be the person who the Father seeks; one who worships Him in Spirit and truth.

Matthew 22:37 - That they will love the Lord their God with all their heart, soul, and mind.

I Corinthians 12:31 - That they will choose the greatest gift of love.

1 Corinthians 14:12 - That they will seek to use their spiritual gift/s for the edification of the church.

2 Corinthians 5:18 & 19 - That they will take seriously that God has committed unto them the ministry of reconciliation.

2 Corinthians 12:9 - That they will recognize that God's grace is sufficient in their trials.

Ephesians 1:17 - That the Father may give to them the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him.

Ephesians 1:19 - That they know what is the exceeding greatness of His power toward them.

Ephesians 2:10 - That they will understand they are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God has already prepared for them to do.

1 Corinthians 6:19-20 - That God will be glorified in their life/lives

Hebrews 13:20-21 - For the will of God to be done in their lives

Hebrews 12:2 - For them to fix their eyes on Jesus, the author and finisher of their faith.

Philippians 4:6-8 - For them to be anxious for nothing and for them to meditate upon good and godly things.

Ephesians 3:19 - That they would be strengthened in the inner person by the power of the Holy Spirit.

Colossians 4:6 - That their speech will be filled with grace.

Ephesians 4:32 - That they will be extremely grateful for God's forgiveness to them and, therefore, willing to forgive others.

Hebrews 10:25 - That they will be faithful in gathering with the saints

1 Corinthians 12:12 - That they will recognize they are a vital part of the body and that they will be faithful to fulfill their part.

Ephesians 4:1 - That they will walk worthy of being a follower of Christ.

1 Peter 5:5 - That they will choose to clothe themselves in humility.

Titus 2:13 - That they will live as a person awaiting the coming of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

Psalms 119: 25 & 28 - That they would look to God's word as a source of renewal and strength.

Psalms 139:14 - That they would invite the Lord to search them for anything not pleasing to Him.

Psalms 19:14 - That the words of their mouth and the meditation of their heart will be acceptable in His sight.

Philippians 4:13 - That they will realize they can do all things through Christ who strengthens them.

2 Corinthians 9:6 & 7 - That they will have great joy in giving.

Romans 14:12 - That they will live with the understanding that someday they will give an account unto the Lord for this life.
