Invite the Holy Spirit to reveal to you the significance of these principles Jesus taught us. Lord, teach us to encounter You in an intimate way as we seek You in prayer. Thank You that we are responding to Your reaching out to us.

Lord, Teach Us to Pray

The **Person** to Whom we pray - *Our Father - The death, burial, and resurrection of Christ reconciled us to God and made us His children.*

The **Position** of the One to whom we pray - Our Father Who is in heaven....He is seated upon the throne and has authority over everything.

The **Praise** due the One to whom we pray - *Hallowed/holy, set* apart be Your name. Lord, may Your name be honored in my life

The **Purpose** for which we pray - Your kingdom come, Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

The **Provision** for which we pray - *Give us this day our daily bread*.

The **Pardon** which we pray - Forgive us our sins as we forgive those who sin against us.

The **Protection** for which we pray. - Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from the evil one.

The **Power** of the One to whom we pray - for Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever.
