## INNER CITIES

**Jamaica Missions Impact Team Board Members raised over \$8,000** to support educational efforts by providing over 20 educational scholarships (books, uniform, transportation/tuition) to those bright children in dire financial need. We also delivered 300 bags with school supplies to FIVE(5) children's homes & 3 large inner cities (Waterhouse/Riverton/Lyndurst- near Trench Town). **The medical team served 440 patients** in these same inner cities while other team members shared testimonies & the gospel.
