This month, JMIT had the opportunity to support Danielle Small, a dedicated student currently enrolled in a Practical Nursing program. Danielle is four months into her one-year course and is working diligently toward a future in healthcare—driven in large part by the encouragement of her grandmother, who raised her and now navigates life in a wheelchair while continuing to champion Danielle's success.

Through the generosity of our donors, Danielle received essential nursing supplies to support her training, including a blood pressure machine, blood glucose monitor, thermometer, stethoscope, first aid kit, nurse apron, and nurse watch. These tools are critical to her day-to-day learning and hands-on practice as she prepares for a career dedicated to caring for others.

Your support is helping remove barriers and turn determination into opportunity. JMIT will continue to follow Danielle's progress in partnership with Principal Row at Riverton Meadows, ensuring accountability, encouragement, and continued support as she moves closer to completing her program and becoming a success story in her community.
