COMMUNITY NEEDS (BODY)

We support 2 inner city communities by partnering with the local churches to support basic needs of the communities. Thanks to your generosity, we purchased a keyboard to provide music lessons to disadvantaged youth in Waterhouse, fans for SOS Children's village and a widow; the chickens we purchased last year are continuing to lay eggs (100 at a time) to feed not only the homes but the community. We provided meals for the children during our VBS, as well as hurricane relief supplies & medical supplies.



SCHOOL SUPPLY DRIVE (MIND)

Given the cost of education for public high school is not free (\$1,500 per child per year), we support educational efforts by delivering 300 book bags and school supplies to FIVE (5) children's homes and 1 large inner city (Waterhouse). We also provided TEN (10) \$100 scholarships to A-B+ school aged youth in need across Kingston through Hope Gospel Assembly back to school program.

VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL 'VBS' (SOUL)

Given child exploitation rates in Jamaica are at times 3X more than global rates, we spend our week at the children's homes (Homestead, Mary's Child [rescue home for teen mom & their babies], SOS) and Waterhouse sharing messages of hope and Christ's love to 200+ children through music, games, crafts, bible stories, and simply investing one on one time with children who have been abused, neglected & abandoned. We've been blessed to see young ladies we have helped for 7 years, now after moving out of the system, become success stories working as good citizens in the airport, banks, call centers, pursuing college education, etc.
