### Hurricanes Junior League Stage 1, Stage 2 and Under 13s

#### Playing Gear

All players from Hurricanes Junior League Stage 1 and up are required to have their own playing gear. Unfortunately, COVID-19 means that no gear can be shared between players as it was in the past.

Junior players will require at a minimum:

- **Abdomen protector** (or 'box') – for boys – not available via our online shop but can be purchased from cricket and sports stores for less than \$10
- **British Standard helmet (BS7928:2013)**. Helmets with adjustable guards are no longer able to be worn, British Standard is the international standard adopted by Cricket Australia and required to be followed by all Australian cricket clubs.
- **Cricket bat** (appropriately sized)
- **Batting gloves**
- **Cricket pads**
- **Cricket bag** to transport gear
- **Playing cap**
- **Sneakers** with a good grip, some kids like to wear a synthetic cricket shoe as they get older, this is a personal preference and not required, good sneakers are more than suitable at this age
- **Water bottle** (named)

Advice regarding wicket keeping gloves will be managed directly with each team.

Additional items are at players/parents' discretion.

All cricket gear must be clearly labelled and should be brought to training and games.
