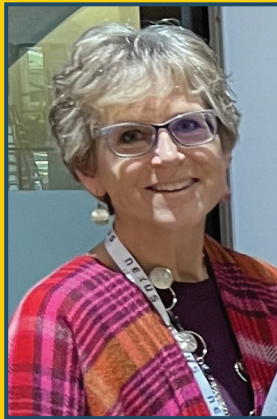

## WATER MARBLE easter eggs

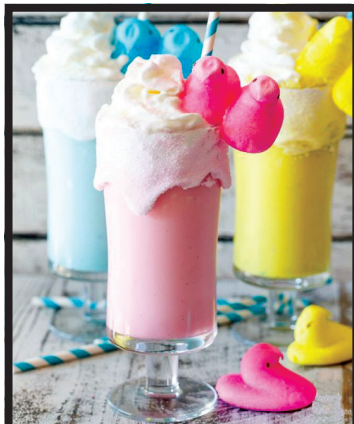


### Materials:

## Cadbury Egg Brownies

**Ingredients:**

- 1 box Dark Chocolate Brownie Mix plus box ingredients
- 1/2 cup Corn Syrup
- 1/4 cup softened Butter
- 3 cup Powdered Sugar
- 1 tsp Vanilla
- Yellow Food Coloring

**Frosting:**

- 12 tablespoons butter
- 4.5 oz unsweetened chocolate, roughly chopped
- 1 1/2 cups chocolate chips
- 1/2 tsp vanilla
- 1 1/2 lb confectioner's sugar
- 1/2 cup whole milk

**Directions:**

Prepare brownies according to the box directions. Cool. Cream corn syrup, butter, and vanilla. Add powdered sugar until incorporated. Transfer 1/2 the filling to another bowl and add yellow food coloring. Spread yellow mix on top of brownies and refrigerate 15 minutes. Spread white mix on top of yellow layer and refrigerate for 15 minutes.

**Frosting:** In a microwave- safe bowl, microwave chocolates and butter together in 30 second intervals, stir until smooth. Stir in vanilla. Add powdered sugar to bowl and mix. Slowly pour chocolate mixture in. Add milk in intervals, only as much as needed for smooth frosting. Spread over brownies.
