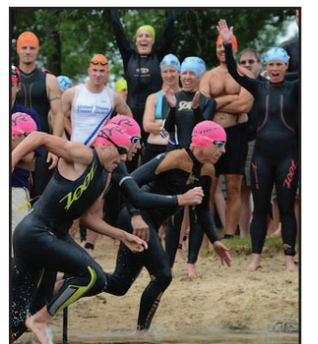

Firecracker - cake -

Ingredients:

1 box (15.25 oz.) white cake mix
Water, vegetable oil and egg whites called for on cake mix
Red food coloring
Blue food coloring
1 (12 oz.) white frosting
Red, white and blue sprinkles,

Directions:

Make cake batter as directed on box. Pour 1 cup of batter into a small bowl; stir in red food coloring until well mixed. Pour another cup of batter into a separate bowl; stir in blue food color until well mixed.

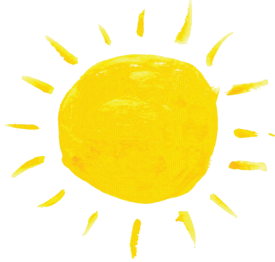
Pour red cake batter into bottom of pan, then white, and lastly blue batter over white. Just pour it in so the colors don't mix.

Bake and cool cake 10 minutes. Place cooling rack over cookie sheet.

Turn pan upside down onto cooling rack. Cool cake completely, about 30-45 minutes. When cake is cool, divide the frosting evenly into 3 bowls.

Microwave bowls of frosting uncovered on HIGH a few seconds until smooth enough to drizzle over cake.

Stir in a few drops of blue and red food coloring into the other bowls until well blended. Add sprinkles and let frosting set.

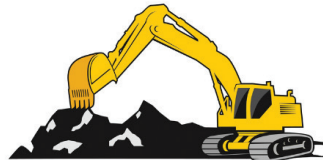
