





#### **Ingredients:**

2 quarts water - (8 cups)
2 family-size tea bag (or 6 standard size bags)
1 cinnamon stick
1 cup sugar
1/2 cup frozen orange juice
concentrate - thawed
1/2 cup frozen lemonade
concentrate - thawed
1/2 cup pineapple juice

#### **Directions:**

In a large saucepan, bring 2 quarts of water to a boil.

Then remove from heat and add tea bags and cinnamon stick

Steep 8-10 minutes. Remove bags. Add sugar and stir. Add oj, lemonade, and pineapple juice. Pour into a pitcher. Chill until cold.

Discard cinnamon stick before pouring into glasses.


