ZUCCHINI BROWNIES

Ingredients:

For the Brownies:
 ½ cup vegetable oil
 1 cup granulated sugar
 ½ cup light brown sugar packed
 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
 2 cups all-purpose flour
 ½ cup dark chocolate unsweetened cocoa powder
 1 ½ teaspoon baking soda
 1 teaspoon kosher salt
 2 ½ cups finely shredded zucchini

For the Frosting:
 ¼ cup unsalted butter melted
 5 Tablespoons dark chocolate unsweetened cocoa powder
 2 cups powdered sugar
 6 Tbsp heavy whipping cream
 ½ teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions:

Cookies:
 Preheat oven to 350 degree F. Line a 13x9 baking dish with parchment paper. Set aside.

For brownies, in a large bowl, combine oil, sugars, and vanilla. Add in flour, cocoa powder, baking soda and salt. Stir together until well blended. Batter will be dry.

Fold in shredded zucchini. Depending on the moisture of your zucchini, your batter may still be slightly dry.

Let batter sit 10 minutes before pouring into baking dish.

Bake for 25-30 minutes until cooked. Remove and cool completely before frosting.

For the frosting: Combine the melted butter with cocoa powder in a small bowl with a whisk. Add in powdered sugar, heavy cream and vanilla. Whisk until smooth.

Spread over cooled brownies. Cut into bars

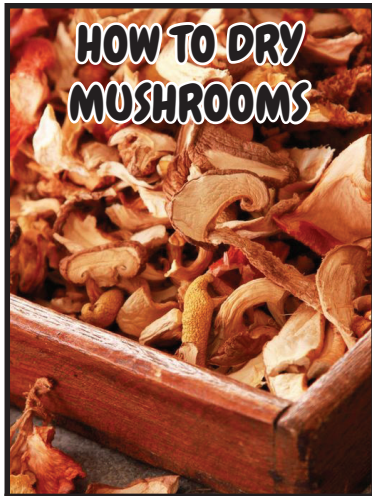

HOW TO DRY MUSHROOMS

Oven Dry:
Preheat the oven to 250 degrees. Once it's heated, turn it down to the WARM setting.

Line a large baking sheet with parchment paper. Fill the baking sheet with slices.

Make sure no pieces are touching or they won't dry correctly.

Put baking sheet in the oven and crack oven door.

Leave mushrooms in oven, with the door open, until they're fully dehydrated.

Be SURE they're fully dried before you remove them.

Grinder Salad

Ingredients:

Dressing:

- 3/4 mayonnaise
- 1 tablespoon red wine vinegar
- 1 teaspoon minced garlic
- 1/8 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 1/8 teaspoon red pepper flakes (optional)

Salad:

- 1 head iceberg lettuce, chopped
- 1/4 cup sliced red onion
- 1 cup diced tomato
- 1/2 cup pepperoncini
- 1/2 cup diced provolone cheese
- 1/2 cup chopped salami
- 1/2 cup chopped pepperoni
- 1/2 cup chopped deli turkey

Directions:

Place mayonnaise, red vinegar, garlic, Parmesan, oregano, salt, pepper, and red pepper flakes. Stir well to combine. Add in sliced onion, pepperoncini, tomatoes, provolone, salami, pepperoni, and turkey.

Top with lettuce and then toss well to combine and coat with the dressing.

HOW TO OVERCOME ANXIETY AT THE DENTIST

Cookies:
1 cup butter (softened)
2 cups brown sugar
2 eggs
1 cup buttermilk
1 teaspoon root beer extract
4 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon salt

3/4 cup butter (softened)

**TREATING "UNTREATABLE" CANCERS:
FUNCTIONAL PROFILING COMES OF AGE**

(NAPSI)—Over 1.8 million Americans are diagnosed with
cancer every year according to the American Cancer Soci-
ety. If you or someone you care about is diagnosed with

The process is called functional profiling, which analyzes

participate and promote the cancer process.

Each human cancer reflects all of its genes, both mutated
and normal, acting together to create what we recognize
as a malignant tumor. But gene changes are only the
starting point and not the final product of cancer develop-
ment. The practice of just analyzing genes is incapable of
capturing the complexity of human tumor biology. Only
Functional analyses can interrogate each patient's tumor
in real time to provide insights that can inform drug se-
lection and treatment decisions.

Because each cancer patient is unique and very different
from one person to the next, drugs that work for one per-
son may not for another, even with exactly the same di-
agnosis. Standard trial-and-error approaches cannot meet

Who Developed the Idea

The pioneer behind this is Los Angeles-based oncologist
Dr. Robert Nagourney, author of "Outliving Cancer" and

testing of cancer cells against potential drugs offers pa-

Dr. Nagourney recognized the short comings of modern
trial and error cancer medicine and decided to do some-
thing about it. Over the past two decades he has amassed
data on over 10,000 patients, providing individualized
therapies that have been shown to double response rates
and improve survival. While major centers continue to of-
fer gene profiles that examine DNA mutations hoping to
find a "magic bullet," those result have been extremely
disappointing with a minority of patient's revealing ac-
tionable findings.
