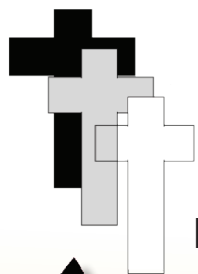

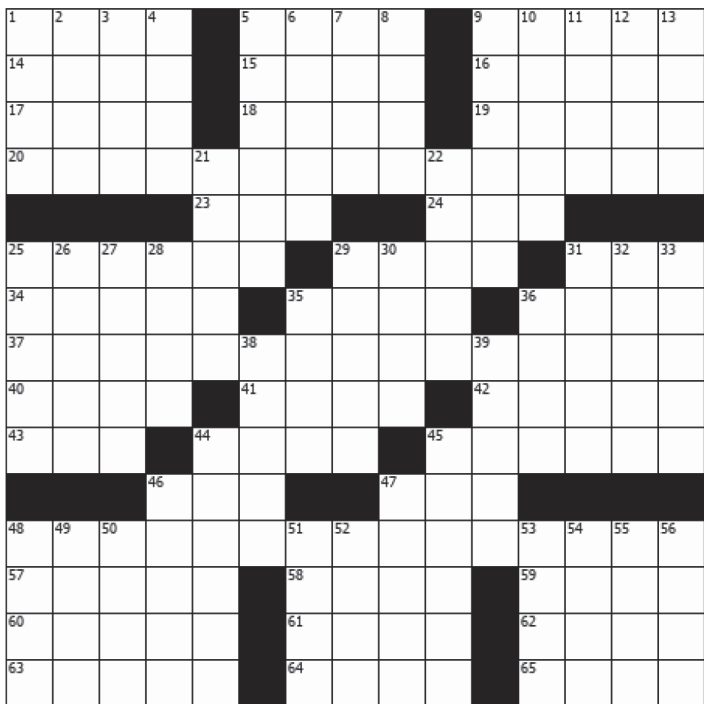

HOW TO DRY & USE LEMON PEEL



Oven Dry:

Zest your lemons (try to get the yellow and not the bitter white pith). Dry the lemon peel in the oven at its lowest setting (about 170° F). The hotter the oven, the darker the dried peel will get. Spread the zest on a baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Let it bake until the peel is dry, shriveled, and crispy. If the zest is very fine, it should be finished in 30 minutes to an hour. When the peel is completely dry, store it in an airtight container. It can also be ground into a powder in a blender. Will store up to 1 year.

STUFFED PEPPER Soup

Ingredients:

- 1 1/2 pounds ground beef
- 1/2 pound ground sausage
- 1 onion diced
- 2 cloves garlic minced
- 1 teaspoon Italian seasoning
- 6 cups low sodium beef broth
- 1 can 16 ounces crushed tomatoes
- 1 can 28 ounces diced tomatoes, undrained
- 2 green bell peppers
- 1 red bell pepper
- 1 teaspoon pepper
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 2 cups cooked long grain white or brown rice
- 2 tablespoons fresh parsley chopped

Directions:

Cook beef, sausage, onion and garlic in a large pot until no pink remains. Drain any fat. Stir in remaining ingredients except rice. Simmer uncovered 25-30 minutes or until peppers are tender. Add rice and parsley and simmer an additional 5 minutes or until heated through.

**ROOT BEER Cookies****Ingredients:****Cookies:**

1 cup butter (softened)
2 cups brown sugar
2 eggs
1 cup buttermilk
1 teaspoon root beer extract
4 cups flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1 teaspoon salt

Frosting:

4 cups powdered sugar
3/4 cup butter (softened)
3 Tablespoons milk
1 teaspoon root beer extract

Directions:**Cookies:**

Preheat oven to 375°. In a mixing bowl, cream butter and brown sugar. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in buttermilk and root beer extract.

Combine flour, baking soda, and salt. Gradually add to creamed mixture. Drop by tablespoonfuls onto ungreased baking sheets. Bake for 10-12 minutes or until lightly browned. Remove to wire racks to cool.

Frosting:

In a mixing bowl, combine all frosting ingredients. Beat until smooth and frost cooled cookies. Syrup will last for 4-5 weeks, once refrigerated. For a thicker syrup: simmer the rhubarb and sugar for a longer period of time until the syrup reduces to a thicker consistency.
