#### **IMPORTANT UPDATE**

Due to rising operating costs and the latest postage increase, we have made the difficult decision to update the Columbia County Shopper from being delivered USPS direct mail to a hybrid system starting August 15th. The shopper will continue to be posted weekly to our website at www.columbiacountyshopper.com and via social media to our Facebook page (www.facebook.com/columbiacountyshopper). The increased benefit to advertisers will be that this will change from mailed to 6,750 residents to reach an increased 8,000-10,000 residents via daily boost targeted social media campaigns. This will include not only Pardeeville, Wyocena, Rio, Doylestown, and Fall River but also the added benefit of a 20 mile radius around Portage, Columbus, Poynette, Cambria-Friesland, Randolph, and Dalton. We will still offer 1,000 physical copies of our weekly paper at all of our current pickup locations throughout Columbia County listed below. We will also expand and add more pickup locations in the future. We hope this will allow us to continue to offer the same quality services for community events and local advertising. 

#### **Ingredients:**

1/4 pound Spicy or Mild Italian Sausage Salt and Pepper 4 Buns 2 Tablespoons Butter 1/2 Teaspoon Garlic Seasoning with Herbs Pizza Sauce Mozzarella Cheese, shredded

1 pound 80% Lean Ground Beef

#### **Directions:**

Pepperoni

Parmesan

Heat the grill to high heat. In a small bowl, melt the butter then stir in the seasoning.

Place the pepperoni in between two paper towels, not overlapping each other.

Microwave for 15 seconds and set aside. Shape the meat into 4 patties...

Place a little sausage in the middle of each and gently fold together.

Then shape into patties again and sprinkle with salt and pepper.

Turn the heat to medium high and place each patty on the grill for 2-3 minutes per side.

Brush each bun with the butter mixture and place on the grill for a minute or until grill marks appear

Place a patty on each bun, top with sauce and cheese, then pepperoni. Sprinkle a little parmesan cheese and top with the lid of the buns.


