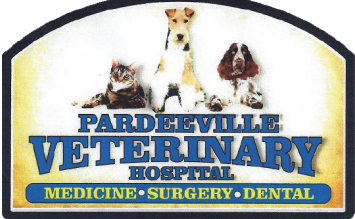

Ingredients:
3 tablespoons butter
2 tablespoons olive oil
2 carrots peeled and sliced
1 large yellow onion peeled and diced
½ red bell pepper seeded and diced
1 zucchini shredded
6 cloves garlic minced
1/3 cup all-purpose flour
9 cups low sodium chicken broth divided
3 tablespoons cornstarch
1 pound cooked chicken chopped
1 tablespoon chicken bouillon
2 bay leaves
1 tablespoon dried parsley
1 tablespoon dried basil
1 teaspoon dried oregano
1 teaspoon dried thyme
1 teaspoon salt
1 teaspoon pepper
¼ teaspoon red pepper flakes
10 lasagna noodles uncooked, broken into 1-2 inch pieces
2-3 cups half and half
½ cup heavy cream optional
8 ounces chopped frozen spinach thawed and drained
1 ½ cups Parmesan cheese grated
Mozzarella cheese shredded, for garnish

Directions:
Sauté the carrots, onions, and peppers in melted butter and oil in a large dutch oven over medium heat. Once they start to soften, add the zucchini and garlic. Then, add the flour, stirring constantly, to make a thick roux. Turn down the heat and add most of the chicken broth slowly. Whisk the cornstarch with a little broth and add that to the pot with the cooked chicken, chicken bouillon, and all the herbs and spices. Next, add the broken lasagna noodles and put on medium-high heat. Bring soup to a boil then reduce it to a simmer until the noodles are fully cooked. Stir. Remove the bay leaves, add the dairy and spinach and parmesan.

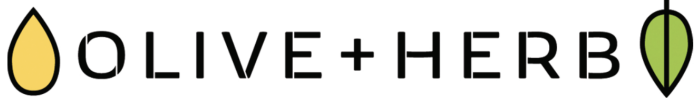
