MAC-O-LANTERN

Ingredients:

Kosher salt
6 medium orange bell peppers
8 ounces elbow macaroni
1 1/4 cups half-and-half
8 ounces cream cheese (at room temperature)
4 ounces mild Cheddar, shredded (about 1 1/2 cups)

Directions:

Bring a large pot of generously salted water to a boil. Fill a large bowl with ice water. Cut the tops off the peppers and reserve. Remove the seeds and membranes. Put the peppers and the tops in the boiling water and cook until just tender, 2 to 3 minutes. Plunge the peppers into the ice bath. Once cool, remove them and use a sharp knife to carve a jack-o-lantern face into one side of each pepper.

Return the water to a boil, add the macaroni and cook until al dente, about 6 minutes. Reserve 1 cup of the pasta water and drain (don't rinse the pasta).

Heat the half-and-half in a large saucepan over medium heat until it just comes to a simmer. Continue simmering until reduced to about 3/4 cup, about 10 minutes. Add the cream cheese and stir until melted. Whisk in the Cheddar until all the cheese is melted and the sauce is smooth. Off the heat, add the macaroni to the saucepan and stir to combine. Stir in some of the reserved pasta water to thin the sauce if needed. Season with salt if needed.

Let sit for 10 minutes, then divide the mac and cheese among the peppers and cap each with a pepper top.

CHOCOLATE PUMPKIN BREAD

- Ingredients:**
- 2 large eggs
 - 1/2 cup (120 g) canned pumpkin puree
 - 1/4 cup (55 g) plain 2% Greek yogurt
 - 1/2 cup (100 g) coconut palm sugar*
 - 6 Tbsp (30 g) unsweetened cocoa powder
 - 2 tsp vanilla extract
 - 1 tsp baking soda

Directions:

Preheat your oven to 350 F, and lightly grease a loaf pan or line it with parchment paper. Set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, lightly beat the eggs until the yolks break apart. Whisk in the pumpkin, yogurt, sugar, cocoa, vanilla, baking soda, and salt, mixing until smooth.

Slowly spoon in the flour and gently stir it in until just combined. Fold in the chocolate chips. Pour batter into the prepared loaf pan, spreading evenly, and sprinkle the top with a few extra chocolate chips. Bake for 40-45 minutes, or until a toothpick inserted comes out clean.

Remove the bread from the oven and let it cool in the pan for about 15 minutes before transferring it to a cooling rack to cool completely. Store the loaf in a sealed container for up to 5 days, or freeze it for up to 3 months.

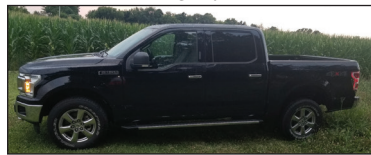
