MAC-O-LANTERN

Ingredients:

Kosher salt 6 medium orange bell peppers 8 ounces elbow macaroni 1 1/4 cups half-and-half 8 ounces cream cheese(at room temperature) 4 ounces mild Cheddar, shredded (about 1 1/2 cups)

<u>Directions</u>:

Bring a large pot of generously salted water to a boil. Fill a large bowl with ice water. Cut the tops off the peppers and reserve. Remove the seeds and membranes. Put the peppers and the tops in the boiling water and cook until just tender, 2 to 3 minutes. Plunge the peppers into the ice bath. Once cool, remove them and use a sharp knife to carve a jack-o-lantern face into one side of each pepper.

Return the water to a boil, add the macaroni and cook until al dente, about 6 minutes. Reserve 1 cup of the pasta water and drain (don't rinse the pasta).

Heat the half-and-half in a large saucepan over medium heat until it just comes to a simmer. Continue simmering until reduced to about 3/4 cup, about 10 minutes. Add the cream cheese and stir until melted. Whisk in the Cheddar until all the cheese is melted and the sauce is smooth. Off the heat, add the macaroni to the saucepan and stir to combine. 

Supplies:

Small pumpkin, Black spray paint (or black acrylic paint and paintbrush), 8 black pipe cleaners, super glue, and Googly eyes. To make:

Paint pumpkin black. Bend pipe cleaners on the end and curve the center for legs. Use a wood skewer if needed to make a prehole for the legs. Add super glue to the ends if desired. Glue the googly eyes and mouth to the front of the pumpkin.


