Ingredients:

10 large apples, quartered 1/2 orange, halved 4 cinnamon sticks 1 tsp. cloves 1 tsp. whole allspice 1 whole nutmeg

1/2 c. packed brown sugar

Directions:

In a large stockpot over medium heat, add apples, oranges, spices, and brown sugar. Cover with water by 2". Bring to a boil, then reduce heat and simmer, covered, 2 hours.

Remove orange halves, then use a potato masher to mash apples. Let simmer uncovered for 1 hour more.

Strain through a fine mesh strainer, pressing solids with a wooden spoon to squeeze juices out. Discard solids. Serve warm.

Pumpkin Gooey Butter Bars

Ingredients:

CRUST:

1 box yellow cake mix

1 large egg

½ cup (1 stick) butter, melted FILLING:

- 1 8 oz package cream cheese, softened
- 1 15 oz can unsweetened pumpkin puree
- 3 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract 1/2 cup (1 stick) butter, melted
- 1 16 oz box powdered sugar 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg

Directions:

Preheat your oven to 350 ... Spray a 9x13 inch baking pan with nonstick spray.

Prepare the crust: In a large bowl, use an electric mixer to combine the cake mix, egg and butter. Pat the mixture into the bottom of your prepared pan.

Prepare the filling: In a large bowl, use an electric mixer to combine the cream cheese and pumpkin until smooth. Add eggs, vanilla and butter. Beat well. Mix in powdered sugar, cinnamon and nutmeg until well-combined.

Spread filling over the cake batter and bake 40-50 minutes. Don't over bake; you want the center to be a little gooey.


