

Study 2: Finding God in the Mundane

Scripture: Colossians 3:23 – “Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters.”

Extended Explanation:

This verse encourages believers to approach all tasks—big or small—with a sense of divine purpose. Even ordinary work becomes sacred when done with the intent to glorify God, reflecting a lifestyle of worship beyond Sunday services.

Key Points with Life Applications:

Every Task is Worship:

All work, when done with love, can glorify God.

Life Application: Set intentions before mundane tasks, like chores or work, dedicating them to God.

God Values Faithfulness in Small Things:

Even small acts matter when done with integrity and effort.

Life Application: Take pride in small achievements, knowing that God honors faithfulness.

Work with Joy, Not for Recognition:

Fulfillment comes not from approval but from serving God wholeheartedly.

Life Application: Practice anonymous acts of kindness, focusing on pleasing God, not people.
