Focus & Funds

BRC is a home for amateur and professional athletes to learn, compete and contribute to a community.

The centre runs various sporting programs that encourage active and healthy living in a safe and professional environment.

By working with academic institutions we can develop talent at the grass-roots level and host major regattas with schools and universities competing.

In addition, we work closely with university teams, National Federations, Community Rowing Organisations such as Community Rowing Inc in Boston USA, as well as various other organisations.

Most importantly, we work closely with the World Rowing Federation, FISA (Fédération Internationale des Sociétés d'Aviron) while completely embracing the values represented by the International Rowing Community.



Exclusive & Central

BRC is located at *Paddle*, in the middle of Bahrain Bay promenade. The outlet will be surrounded by first-class hospitality outlets and the country's most iconic landmarks.

We are the exclusive rowing operator in the bay - a protected area that ensures non-interfering traffic and controlled conditions on the water. There is ample parking in the vicinity and purpose-built facilities for our users.

This prime location allows BRC to organise and host international events, offering world-class visibility to our local spectators while facilitating extraordinary levels of international exposure.

History

Our history is central to our identity and our aspirations. Bahrain's ancient maritime heritage is rich, colourful, and deeply ingrained in our way of life.

Bahrain and indeed other gulf countries have held important positions as major naval outposts, trading centres, and as prized pearling grounds that gained fame all over the world.

Today, it continues to hold major naval significance, hosting the base of the US Fifth Fleet and the British Royal Navy.

At BRC our focus is not limited to the mere conservation of these roots, but also on cultivating them for us and for future generations. To that end, we work closely with authorities such as Bahrain Authority for Culture and Antiquities as well as other stakeholders.



"In 1838, Lieutenant J. R., Wellsted, an officer in the British India service, underscored the prowess of Bahrain's maritime commerce capability. He reported that the fisheries of the gulf employed 4,300 boats, manned more than 30,000 men.

Of these boats, 3,500 were from the Island of Bahrain, 100 from the Persian coast, and the remaining 700 from the Pirate Coast situated between Bahrain and the entrance to the Gulf of Oman." Lieutenant Wellsted estimated the value of the pearls secured annually as approximately 400,000 British pounds, which is somewhat less than the average value of the output in recent years."

Core Activities

BRC offers a variety of sub disciplines of rowing and canoeing:

Rowing

We offer guidance and training to all athletes, professionals and beginners, passing down the principles, values, and techniques of the sport. We have a fleet of various boat sizes in scull and sweep format for Olympic and coastal rowing. We work closely with FISA regulations and standards.

Dragon Boat

Popular in South East Asia, Dragon Boats are excellent for team building. This thrilling form of canoeing which is quick to learn. Each boat will initially hold 10 rowers and 1 drummer in the front to set the pace. Highly popular across the world, dragon boat racing offers a fun, exciting and very competitive activity to all. IDCF is the governing body for Dragon Boat

Canoeing

Professional canoeing brings a twist to the traditional rowing format and allows each individual to perfect their own different style and technique. Our soon to arrive canoes will allow you to explore the open sea and perform under all type of weather conditions. IDBF is the governing body for canoeing and its various disciplines.

RP3 Rowing

For those who feel like training on land or indoor, our RP3 machines are considered the best dynamic rowing simulators in the world with full mobile integration and tracking. The RP3 is used by elite country and varsity teams.



What to Wear & Bring

BRC exercises a strict attire policy with your safety and comfort in mind.

This includes wearing snug, well fitted clothes to avoid getting caught in the rigging and ensuring BRC is presentable like any reputable team.

You can either wear a white t-shirt with black shorts or leggings, or BRC approved outfits that can be specific to your personal, academic or corporate team.

BRC also offers a range of apparel and merchandise to choose from.


Our Founders & Friends


