**Volunteer Release and Waiver of Liability Form**  
COVID-19 Education Farm Volunteer

This Release and Waiver of Liability (“*Release*”) executed on \_\_\_\_\_ by \_\_\_\_\_ (“*Volunteer*”), releases Orange Home Grown Foundation (“*Nonprofit*”) a 501c3 nonprofit corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of California as well as each of its directors, officers, employees, and agents. The Volunteer desires to provide services for this Nonprofit and engage in activities related to serving as a volunteer.

**This waiver and release includes, but not limited to, any infection or illness related to COVID19 which the volunteer may contract as a result of his or her activities or presence related to the Orange Home Grown nonprofit. Additionally volunteer acknowledges and agrees to follow all steps and social distancing as recommended or directed by governmental orders and directives, as well as those set forth in the attached Reminders which the volunteer acknowledges having read and agreed to.**

Volunteer understands that the scope of the Volunteer’s relationship with the Nonprofit is limited to a volunteer position and that no compensation is expected in return for services provided by the Volunteer; that the Nonprofit will not provide any benefits traditionally associated with employment to the Volunteer; and that the Volunteer is responsible for his/her own insurance coverage in the event of personal injury or illness as a result of their volunteer service to this Nonprofit.

1. *Waiver and Release:* I, the Volunteer, release and forever discharge and hold harmless this Nonprofit and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind of nature, either in law or in equity, which arise or may hereafter arise from the services I provide to the Nonprofit. I acknowledge that this Release discharges the Nonprofit from any and all liability or claim that I may have against the Nonprofit with respect to bodily injury, personal injury, illness, death, or property damage that may result from the services I provide to the Nonprofit or occurring while I am providing volunteer services.
2. *Insurance:* I understand that the Nonprofit does not assume any responsibility for or obligation to provide me with financial or other assistance, including but not limited to medical, health or disability benefits or insurance of any nature in the event of my injury, illness, death or damage to my property. I expressly waive any such claim for compensation or liability on the part of the Nonprofit beyond what may be offered freely by the Nonprofit in the event of such injury or medical expenses incurred by me.
3. *Medical Treatment:* I hereby Release and forever discharge the Nonprofit from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first-aid treatment or other medical services rendered in connection with an emergency during my tenure as a volunteer with the Nonprofit.
4. *Photographic Release:* I grant and convey to the Nonprofit all rights, title, and interests in any and all photographs, images, video, or audio recording of me or my likeness or voice made by the nonprofit in connection with my providing volunteer services to the Nonprofit.

We will provide updates as the situation on COVID-19 evolves. We will also do our best efforts in preventing the spread of disease by doing the following:

- All volunteers must wear a face covering (available by OHG if needed)
- All volunteers must bring their own gardening gloves (available by OHG if needed)
- All volunteers to maintain at least a 6' distance from anyone they encounter. As a contribution to the group environment, we ask you that you practice social distancing when in public even though you may be volunteering in a family group.
- All volunteers will wash hands when entering and exiting the Farm.
- All volunteers will maintain only 1 person at a time in the shed or in the greenhouse.
