How We Support Your Child

For every child (Universal Support):

- A safe, inclusive, and welcoming environment
- Nurturing relationships with a key person who knows your child well
- Learning through play, exploration, and encouragement

For children needing a little extra help (Targeted Support):

- A personalised support plan with small, achievable goals, planned and reviewed using the Graduated Approach (Assess – Plan – Do – Review)
- Extra encouragement and adult support at key times of the day
- Opportunities to build confidence, friendships, and communication skills

For children with higher needs (Specialist Support):

- Close partnership with outside professionals (e.g. Speech & Language, Educational Psychology, SEND Hub)
- Guidance and support for families if an EHCP (Education, Health & Care Plan) is needed
- Additional funding (where available) used for staff, training, or resources to meet individual needs

Working With Families

- Regular updates on your child's progress
- Shared planning between home and pre-school
- Stay & Play sessions and reviews so you can see learning in action
- Open communication with your key person and SENDCo
- Support for smooth transitions to school or another setting, including shared plans and meetings with new teachers
