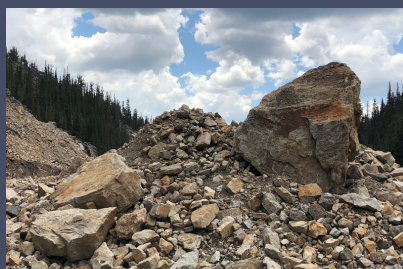

Introducing Vicary Quarry and
Racehorse Shale Pit

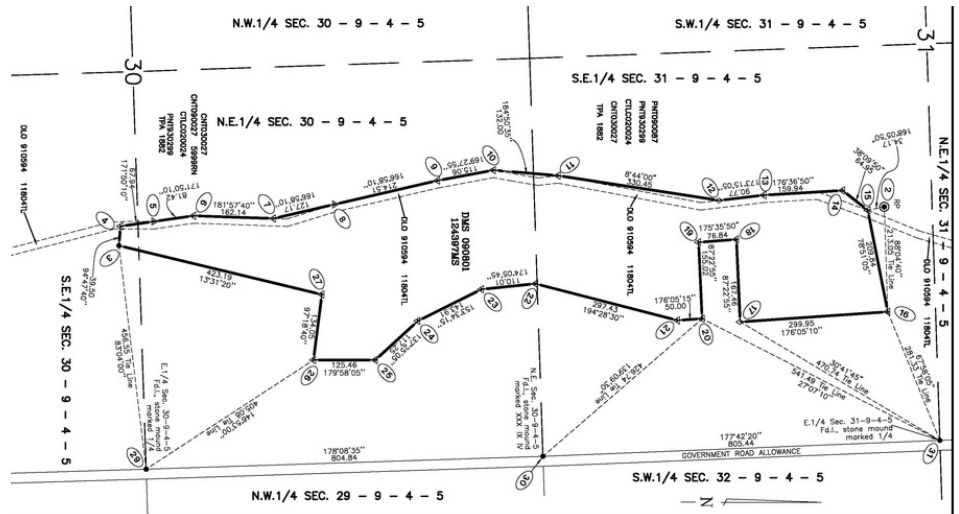


Detail

- Vicary Quarry is located 15 km north of Coleman, AB, just off Highway 40.
- Vicary holds an estimated 22 million tonnes of Elk Valley Conglomerate and up to 6 million tonnes of Rundlestone, non-blasted.
- Vicary features 2 distinct products: Elk Valley conglomerate and Rundlestone. Both test similar to granite.
- Vicary has been used for large-scale riprap projects since the 1980s, including the Oldman Dam and flood mitigation in Calgary and High River.
 - The quarry is fully operational and rock can be sorted into 8 to 12 products depending on setup.
 - The plant can operate up to 600mT per hour, with room for additional processing.
 - Rock sizes range from sand-sized chips to individual rock pieces the size of a pickup truck.
 - Site access can be maintained all year

- The Racehorse shale pit is 5 km north of Vicary Quarry on Highway 40.
- Shale can be screened or crushed to desired sizes.
- An axle scale is available at site and the Vicary Scale can be used as an alternate.
- The disposition has 530,000mT of product.
- Site access can be maintained all year.

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
