COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS January 21, 2025

The Jewell County Commissioners met January 21, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Brent Beck, Ervin Underwood, and Ed Duskie were present. Myka Zadina, County Clerk, was present for the meeting.

Kenny McCary discussed the airport project with the Commissioners and asked if they would sign a letter of commitment to submit with the grant.

Amanda Davis, Register of Deeds, presented two bids for Federal Tax Lein Record Binders. One bid from Bear Graphics for \$1320.00 and a second bid from Navrat's for \$1190.00. Brent Beck moved, and Ervin Underwood seconded to accept the bid from Navrat's for \$1190.00. Motion passed unanimously.

Shannon Meier, Ambulance Director, went over December activity reports. Shannon asked for a 5-minute executive session to discuss non-elected personnel. Ed Duskie moved, and Brent Beck seconded to go into executive session for 5 minutes starting at 8:49 a.m. Regular session resumed at 8:54 a.m. with no action taken.

Ervin Underwood moved, and Ed Duskie seconded, to approve Resolution 25-04 road closure. Motion Passed unanimously.

The County Commissioners conducted two interviews for the Jewell County Ambulance Director position.

Ed Duskie moved, and Ervin Underwood seconded, to go into executive session for 10 minutes starting at 10:55 a.m. to discuss EMS personnel. Regular session resumed at 11:05 a.m. with Ervin Underwood moving to offer the position of Ambulance Director to Vincent Urbaniak. Motion passed unanimously.
