

COMMISSIONERS PROCEEDINGS

June 16th, 2025

The Jewell County Commissioners met on June 16th, 2025, at 8:30 a.m. Commissioners Ed Duskie, Brent Beck and Ervin Underwood were present. Myka Zadina, County Clerk, was present at the meeting.

Brent Beck moved, and Ervin Underwood seconded to approve the June 9th, 2025, Commissioner minutes.

The commissioners signed payroll vouchers.

Ed Duskie signed the interlocal service contract between area county commissions and county health departments for the development of coordinated environmental planning and the implementation of environmental programs.

Ed Duskie stated he went and looked at the cement apron placed around the Health Department and stated he doesn't think it is sloped and that's what is causing the water to run back to the basement.

Vincent Urbaniak reviewed the ambulance 2026 budget.

Myriah Wanklyn discussed the Unified Court 2026 Budget.

Tanya Paul DVACK presented the June 2025 Elder Abuse Awareness month proclamation. Ervin Underwood moved to proclaim June 2025 Elder Abuse Awareness month, Brent Beck seconded. Motion passed unanimously.

Ed Duskie stated he has heard positive comments about the work done on the Randall Rd.



Ervin also inquired about residents paying for the gravel and the county hauling it to place on non FAS roads.

Kevin Peroutek discussed the 2026 budget. He also discussed getting a quote for repairing rust on the bumper of the emergency preparedness truck.

Cindy gave a report regarding grant reimbursement for wages.


The meeting was adjourned at 10:35 a.m.
